#### **Snake Gobbler**

What you need: Playdough

Give a piece of playdough to your child and have them roll it into a snake. You or another sibling can do the same. Tell them that one snake is going to gobble up the other(s). When that happens, attach the snakes to create one longer snake. Challenge them to continue gobbling up the other snake(s) until it becomes the longest snake possible. Remind them that in today's story a snake gobbled up two other snakes. Ask your child if they remember why that happened.

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#### **The Floor is Lava**

What you need: Masking tape, paper plates (at least 5)

In today's true Bible story, Moses had a really hard job to do, but God gave him a friend to help him. God gives us friends who help too. We're going to play a game where we get to practice helping each other.

Place two parallel tape lines on the floor about 12–15 feet apart. Spread out the paper plates between the two lines. The object of the game is to get from one tape line to the other, but the

space in between the tape is hot lava. They cannot cross it unless they step on the “stepping stones” or use them as “lava shoes”. You or another sibling can help them cross IF using the paper plates to get to them. Be prepared for some good laughs!
